COVID-19: Bulletin No. 4 April 03, 2020

Changes for Air and Sea Cargo Operations

As per the issued directives of the Government of Saint Lucia, in relation to its response to COVID-19, the air and sea ports and related business remain operational with variations to its procedures.

During the imposed 24-hour curfew period, from 5:00 a.m. Wednesday April 01, 2020 to 5:00 a.m. Wednesday April 08, 2020, the Saint Lucia Air and Sea Ports Authority (SLASPA) will work with the relevant authorities to ensure the following:

- Cargo vessel operations will continue as scheduled.
- Air Cargo operations will continue at both airports within the established aerodrome operational hours. HIA – 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. daily and GFLC – 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday to Friday. The aerodrome at GFLC is closed on Saturday and Sunday.
- The delivery of both air and sea related cargo will be limited to the essential services as identified by the National Emergency Management Office (NEMO).

The Authority will extend the free storage period of all cargo at Port Castries and Vieux Fort to coincide with the duration of the above curfew period.

Consequently, authorized personnel who will be transacting business at these locations are mandated to adhere to the established social distancing and sanitizing protocol.
